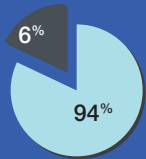


# Ransomware survey: A look at the current situation



Ransomware continues to dominate the headlines. A new survey by Ontrack looks at the global view of ransomware, how prepared organisations are for an attack, and how much data could be recovered when an attack occurred.



## Global View

**94%**

think it's either very important or important to prepare their organisation for a ransomware attack

**6%**

don't think it's important or have a neutral view on preparing their organisation for a ransomware attack



## Managing risk

**61%**

have an emergency plan in place for a ransomware attack

**39%**

either have no emergency plan in place or are not aware if one exists

**79%**

included data recovery as part of their emergency plan



## Ransomware and data

**74%**

of those hit with a ransomware attack could access a working backup of their data

**21%**

have experienced a ransomware attack

**26%**

of those hit with ransomware couldn't access a working backup of their data



## A working backup is key

**78%**

of those that had access to a working backup could restore the majority of their data.

**22%**

of those that had access to a working backup could restore only a partial amount or no data at all.
